

MIGRANTS' RIGHTS ~ LOCAL RESOURCES

The Southern Poverty Law Center's Southeast Immigrant Freedom Initiative enlists and trains volunteer lawyers to provide free legal representation to detained immigrants facing deportation proceedings in the Southeast.

Project South's University Sin Fronteras provides a public and accessible space for education that reflects the principles, concerns, and ethics of global people's struggles and advances systemic social change.

Freedom University provides college preparation classes, college and scholarship application assistance, and leadership development for undocumented students in Georgia.

Georgia Latino Alliance for Human Rights educates, organizes, and empowers Latinos/Latinas and immigrants in Georgia to defend and advance their civil and human rights.

New Sanctuary Movement of Atlanta is an interfaith, multicultural immigrant rights organization that provides training to support sanctuary congregations and court watch programs as well as facilitating community forums, vigils, and lectures.

Latino Community Fund Georgia supports Latino-serving and Latino-led nonprofits in Georgia with advocacy, program development, technical assistance, and grant making.

Los Vecinos de Buford Highway (The Neighbors of Buford Highway) is a grassroots organization that cultivates community gatherings, magnifies the voices of its residents, and grows future leaders, with a focus on housing and immigration.

Latino LinQ provides support to Latinx people of any sexual orientation and any gender identity by providing direct services and facilitating information, education, and training sessions for individuals and groups.

Lifting Latinx Voices of the Feminist Women's Health Center works for reproductive justice by providing services and activities, including workshops, house parties, and training for community health workers in a culturally appropriate way considering language barriers, immigration status, and stigma attached to sex and abortion.

National Asian Pacific American Women's Forum works to advance social justice and human rights for Asian American and Pacific Islander women and girls.
